 - Be sure to neatly write your **first** and **last name**, your **teacher's name**, and your **grade level** on each Recommendation Form before giving it to your teacher. Do not accept forms back from teachers. They are to be returned to advisors only. Please fill out teacher signature form attached to application.
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- ✓ **The above stated requirements are due no later than September 22nd, 2023.**
 - ✓ **Applicants will not be considered for membership unless all requirements are met by the due date.**
 - ✓ **Turn in your completed Application Form AND your Report Card to Ms. Troyer in Room 924.**

- Applicant is expected to complete **10** community/academic service hours.

III. Leadership

- Applicant must demonstrate leadership in promoting school activities, contribute ideas that improve the civic life of the school, exemplify a positive attitude, be dependable, and be a role model for peers.

IV. Character

- Applicant must consistently uphold principles of morality, ethics, kindness, reliability, and trustworthiness. In addition, the applicant must agree to observe school rules and show courtesy, concern, and respect for others.

Additional Responsibilities:

- To enroll in and maintain a fully academic curriculum.
- To attend regular, special, and committee meetings.
- To participate in NJHS special projects.
- To actively demonstrate and develop qualities of leadership, service, and character.
- To pay annual dues, not to exceed \$20.
