- Applicant is expected to complete 10 community/academic service hours.

III. Leadership

Applicant must demonstrate leadership in promoting school activities, contribute ideas that
improve the civic life of the school, exemplify a positive attitude, be dependable, and be a role
model for peers.

IV. Character

 Applicant must consistently uphold principles of morality, ethics, kindness, reliability, and trustworthiness. In addition, the applicant must agree to observe school rules and show courtesy, concern, and respect for others.

Additional Responsibilities:

- To enroll in and maintain a fully academic curriculum.
- To attend regular, special, and committee meetings.
- To participate in NJHS special projects.
- To actively demonstrate and develop qualities of leadership, service, and character.
- To pay annual dues, not to exceed \$20.
