





- STUDENTS MOST CURRENT GRADE INCLUDING MISSING ASSIGNMENTS IS POSTED ON HAC.
- HAC IS FOR YOUR CHILD'S OVERALL GRADE.

SJCSD Middle School Grading Policy

Formative Assessment-30%



BEGINNING SPANISH (7TH GRADE) INTERMEDIATE SPANISH (8TH GRADE)

Spanish-7th & 8th Graders

Course content for Beginning Spanish and Intermediate Spanish could be equivalent to high school Spanish 1 Credit

- Students who earn an A or B in these two courses and have shown
 mastery of the skills from Beginning Spanish and Intermediate Spanish
 could earn high school standard credit for Spanish 1. These students
 will be eligible to enroll in Spanish 2 in the 9th grade. This is not an
 honors high school credit.
- The Spanish 1 grade will be determined by the numerical average of the final grades for Beginning and Intermediate Spanish and will remain on the student's permanent high school transcript.



6TH-8TH GRADE PE

- ALL 6TH, 7TH, AND 8TH STUDENTS TAKE A FULL YEAR OF P.E.
- STUDENTS MUST HAVE A PE UNIFORM




INTENSIVE READING


